This state-of-the-art ZF eight-speed automatic transmission will be available on rear-wheel and all-wheel-drive Dodge Charger models equipped with the award-winning 3.6-liter Pentastar V-6 engine, delivering 292 horsepower along with improved performance and class-leading fuel efficiency with respect to:

- Best-in-class highway fuel economy (31 mpg highway)
- Best-in-class V-6 AWD fuel economy (18 mpg city and 27 mpg highway)
- Best-in-class combined fuel economy (23 mpg with RWD, 21 mpg with AWD)
- Unsurpassed city fuel economy (19 mpg city RWD, 18 mpg AWD)
- Overall unsurpassed fuel economy in its class (19 mpg city and 31 mpg highway with RWD)

Combined with the award-winning 292 horsepower 3.6-liter Pentastar V-6 engine, the

For an even more engaging driving experience, the 2012 Dodge Charger now introduces new paddle shifters with "Sport" shift mode, standard on the Dodge Charger SXT and SXT Plus equipped with the Rallye Appearance Group or Blacktop package. New touring-tuned AWD suspension

With the introduction of AWD on the new Pentastar V-6 powered 2012 Charger, Dodge engineers took the new second-generation architecture further with the addition of hydrobushings for even more precise all-weather handling and world-class refinement.
