Christopher G. Fields was appointed Senior Vice President, Employee Relations and Manufacturing Human Resources on October 6, 2021. In this position, Fields oversees U.S. and Canada Manufacturing and Parts Distribution Centers Employee Relations; Labor Economics & Benefit Finance; Wage & Salary Administration; and the Center for Employee Development as well as the human resources function for Manufacturing.
