To qualify for a Residual Value Award, the vehicle must be on sale by January 1 and included in the January /February Canadian Black Book Residual Value guide. Value forecasts are based on 48 months of age with an annual average of 24,000 kilometres driven.

Prior to these awards, Stellantis vehicles including Jeep® Wrangler and Dodge Challenger were also named winners in Canadian Black Book's established Best Retained Value Awards.

Class-leading ride and handling is accomplished via a class-exclusive link-coil rear (2500) suspension system with optional rear air suspension (2500 and 3500). The Ram Heavy Duty relentlessly gives maximum effort with the segment's most capability, refinement and operator comfort features.
