**Plant History:** Facility was completed in 1968. The plant has been producing various vehicles for domestic and export markets since that time. Production of the iconic Chrysler PT Cruiser ended on July 9, 2010, after more than 10 years and more than 1.3 million vehicles sold. The plant began producing the Fiat 500 in December 2010. The Fiat version of the Dodge Journey, the Freemont, started production in March 2011. The plant built the one millionth Fiat 500 in November 2012. Production of the all-new Jeep Compass began on Jan. 16, 2017.

**World Class Manufacturing Accomplishments**

In March 2015, Toluca achieved the bronze award level in World Class Manufacturing (WCM). WCM is a methodology that focuses on eliminating waste, increasing productivity, and improving quality and safety in a systematic and organized way. It engages the workforce to provide and implement suggestions on how to improve their jobs and their plants.
